## Increased Aircraft Activity and Noise during Legacy of Liberty Air Show

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. - Residents of the Tularosa Basin may notice an increase in aircraft traffic and aircraft noise as Holloman AFB prepares for and conducts the 2022 Legacy of Liberty Air Show.

Although the air show is only taking place May $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$, there will be an increase of aircraft traffic the days before and after the show as performers arrive and depart Holloman AFB.

The noise during the 2022 Legacy of Liberty aerial demonstrations will be manageable. However, there is the potential for loud noises, to include sonic booms. Hearing protection is recommended, especially for children, and a limited quantity will be available for any spectators that may need them.

The free, two-day event is open to the public and performances will be the same on Saturday and Sunday. Gates open at 8AM each day. Parking is limited so carpooling is highly recommended.

DoD ID card holders and those who need handicap parking should enter through the Main gate to the base. The general public (non DoD ID card holders) will enter using the West gate which is approximately one mile west of the Main gate on Highway 70. Inbound air show traffic through the West Gate will stop at $3 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$.

DoD ID card holders who wish to sponsor a non-DoD ID card holder must follow the pre-enrollment process to obtain a visitor pass no later than May $2^{\text {nd }}$. For more information, email 49sfs.pass@us.af.mil.
