Below are actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of April 2017.

Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum.

Courts-Martial:

- An Airman First Class, 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, was court martialed for wrongful use of cocaine, LSD, ecstasy, and marijuana. The member pled guilty to the charge and its specifications. A military judge sentenced the member to be reprimanded, to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit \$1,066.00 pay per month for 6 months, to perform hard labor without confinement for 3 months, to be confined for 4 months, and to be discharged from the service with a bad conduct discharge.
- A Senior Airman, 49th Operations Support Squadron, was court martialed for wrongful use of marijuana, cocaine, wrongful possession of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine, and wrongful use of Psilocybin. The member pled not guilty to the charge and its specifications. A panel of officer members found the member guilty. The panel sentenced the member to be reprimanded, to be reduced to the grade of E-2, to forfeit \$250.00 pay per month for 6 months, and to perform hard labor without confinement for 3 months.

Article 15 Actions:

- An Airman First Class, 49th Maintenance Squadron, received an Article 15 for absence without leave. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman, 30 days extra duty, and a reprimand.
- An Airman First Class, 16th Training Squadron, received an Article 15 for providing alcoholic beverages to persons
 under the legal drinking age of 21. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman, forfeiture of
 \$150.00 pay, and a reprimand.
- A Staff Sergeant, 49th Medical Support Squadron, received an Article 15 for absence without leave. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, forfeiture of \$175.00 pay per month for 2 months, 7 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for drug abuse. The member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge characterization.
- An Airman Basic, 49th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for Commission of a Serious Offense, Other Serious Offenses. The member received a General discharge characterization.
- An Airman First Class, 54th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for conditions that interfere with military service. The member received an Honorable discharge characterization.
- An Airman First Class, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for drug abuse. The member received
 a General discharge characterization.
- An Airman First Class, 9th Attack Squadron, was discharged for conditions that interfere with military service. The
 member received an Honorable discharge characterization.
