MEMORANDUM FOR ALL HOLLOMAN AFB PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Authorized Transport and Storage of Privately Owned Firearms (POF)

- 1. Security is a priority on every military installation. With an implementation date of January 1, 2017, Holloman AFB transitions into a new element of personal security by allowing personnel with proper credentials to transport POF on Holloman AFB.
- 2. This program will allow active duty, active duty dependents and DoD civilians assigned to Holloman AFB to transport their POF in their vehicles while on Holloman AFB. The program applies to **personnel with valid concealed weapons permit issued by the following states: AK, AZ, AR, CO, DE, FL, ID, KS, LA, MI, MS, MO, NE, NM, NV, NC, ND, OH, OK, SC, TN, TX, VA, WV, WY**. When the occupant is not in the vehicle the POF **MUST** remain out of public view, be stored inside a locked container or storage compartment (glove compartment/trunk), and the vehicle will be locked. Personnel **WILL NOT** be allowed to store POFs in motorcycles. The POF will remain inside the vehicle at all time unless transporting to SF Armory, on-base residence, or authorized base shooting activity.
- 3. POFs will not be allowed on Holloman school property (parking lots, school grounds) along with the preschool parking lot between Building 647 and 650. Storage of POFs in vehicles parked in dormitory parking lots will not be permitted. Dorm residents must store their POFs inside the SF Armory. Alcohol will not be consumed within 8 hours while the POF is in the vehicle and personnel must declare their POF during any vehicle inspections, search or traffic stop. Alcohol **WILL NOT** be consumed at any on base liquor establishment while POF is stored inside the vehicle.
- 4. Failure to abide by set standards could result in revocation of privilege to transport and store POF.
- 5. Authorized users with the proper Concealed Carry credentials must register their POF with Security Forces, upon implementation on January 1, 2017. This program will be valid thru FPCON BRAVO and may be suspended at any time by the 49 WG/CC or SFS/CC.
