


Station News

This year has brought about some great changes to our volunteer program here at Holloman. One of these great changes is the Red Cross Volunteer Dental Assistant Training Program, which we have been working closely with the Dental Clinic to implement. ID card holders of active duty, retired, or base-employed civilians are eligible to apply to the program. Volunteers must be dedicated and have the ability to be there through every phase of this 6 month program. The first few weeks will be academic study with the remainder of the program being hands on experience. Upon completion of the course volunteers will be awarded a certificate for 800 hours of Dental Assisting. We at the Red Cross would like to sincerely thank those involved in getting this program up and running, Colonel Gavron MDG/CC, Lt.Colonel Peters, Lt. Colonel Holiday, and SSgt Rosenbeck.
