HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE LOWERS HPCON TO BRAVO

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. – In response to the improving COVID-19 situation in the immediate and surrounding areas, Col. Ryan Keeney, 49th Wing commander, has lowered the Health Protection Condition to Bravo at Holloman Air Force Base effective June 5, 2020.

The base was at HPCON Charlie since March 25, 2020.

HPCON levels set additional actions for installations based on health threats to base personnel. HPCON Bravo is the second step beyond the normal baseline, and acknowledges a moderate health threat, and sets strict preemptive, precautionary measures. These strict measures are taken from the Department of Defense and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

The public health emergency at HAFB remains in place to have adequate safety and security measures to continue to help protect the base populace and surrounding community.

Although the gradual easing of some restrictions on base has begun, the base posture remains the same, including base access.
