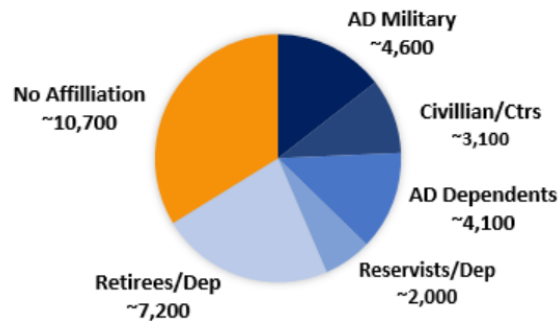

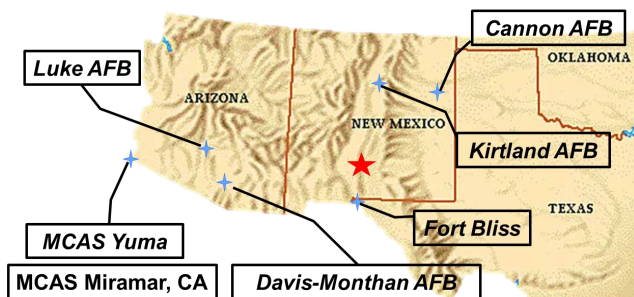

History

Holloman Air Force Base was originally established in 1942 as Alamogordo Air Field six miles west of Alamogordo, New Mexico. Initial construction began at the airfield February 6, 1942. The base was renamed in 1948 in honor of Col. George Holloman, a native of Rich Square, North Carolina, who was a pioneer in early rocket and pilot-less aircraft research.

Fact Sheet

The 49th Wing supports national security objectives by deploying worldwide support to peacetime and war-time contingencies. The wing provides combat-ready Airmen and trains F-16 Viper pilots and MQ-9 Reaper pilots and sensor operators. Additionally, the wing supports the delivery of Air Transportable Clinics and Basic Expeditionary Airfield Resources while providing support to 21,200 military and civilian personnel. The wing has a proud history of service in World War II, Korea, Southeast Asia, Southwest Asia, and NATO-led Operation Allied Force.

MQ-9 Training

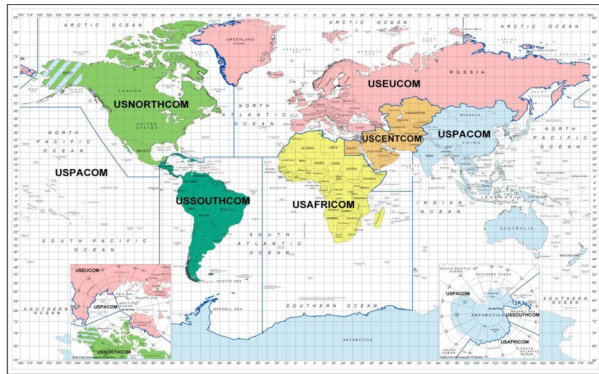
- ◆ 24 MQ-9s — Largest location in USAF
