54th FG TO CONDUCT NIGHT FLYING OPS

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. – F-16 pilots from the 54th Fighter Group here will conduct routine night flying operations April 9-11, 2018.

Residents in the local and surrounding areas can expect aircraft noise in the evening with aircraft landing as late as 11:30 p.m. The biggest impact to the local community will be noise generated when the aircraft take off.

"The 54th Fighter Group trains an average of 180 students per year in an extensive flying hour program that includes day and night training," said Col. Rusty Keen, 54th Fighter Group commander. "Learning how to be proficient at nighttime air operations takes a lot of practice, but there is no room for error in our job and this skill is how we own the night and defeat our enemies."
