COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Updated 10 March 2022

Q1: Are COVID-19 boosters available on base?

A1: Yes, 49 MDG has a supply of Pfizer-BioNTech for beneficiaries age 12 and older and Moderna boosters for beneficiaries age 18 and older.

Q2: Where can I get the booster?

A2: Visit the immunizations office within the 49 MDG to get the booster shot, which is located on the first floor.

Q3: What are the immunization office's hours?

A3: Office hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. However they are closed for training on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of March. In April, they are closed the 1st and 3rd Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and will be open in the morning for vaccinations on those days. Immunizations closed everyday from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Q4: Do I need the same brand of booster as the type I received my initial COVID-19 vaccines?

A4: No, the booster shot can be taken with any initial COVID-19 vaccine. Depending on what type of first vaccine(s) you received, there will be different recommended booster shot dates. For Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna, the CDC recommends to receive the booster shot five months after the last dose in the primary series. For Johnson & Johnson's Janssen, the CDC recommends to receive the booster shot two months after the first dose.

Q5: If I get the booster off base will it be accepted for my records?

A5: Yes, receiving the COVID-19 vaccines and booster shots are acceptable from off base locations. Bring your updated vaccine card to the 49 MDG to have your vaccine records updated.
