Below are the actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of February 2016.

Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum.

Courts-Martial:

- None

Article 15 Actions:

- An Airman First Class, 49 MXS, received an Article 15 for dereliction of duty by possessing alcohol while under the legal drinking age of 21. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman, 21 days extra duty, and a reprimand.
- A Technical Sergeant, 54 AMXS, received an Article 15 for transporting and carrying a privately owned weapon on base in violation of Holloman Air Force Base's Privately Owned Weapons Rules. The member received a reduction to the grade of Staff Sergeant, 14 days extra duty, and a reprimand.
- A Staff Sergeant, 54 AMXS, received an Article 15 for dereliction of duty (failing to follow a Technical Order), and signing a false official record. The member received a reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, 14 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman First Class, 49 OSS, was discharged for Conditions that Interfere with Military Service—Adjustment Disorder. The member received an Honorable discharge characterization.
- An Airman First Class, 49 SFS, was discharged for Failure in Alcohol Abuse Treatment, Unwillingness to Cooperate, and Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The member's misconduct included: disruptive, and disrespectful behavior, and belittling the Alcohol & Drug Abuse Prevention & Treatment (ADAPT) program group process, being intoxicated while enrolled in ADAPT, disrespecting a SNCO, failing to uphold standards by asking a coworker to send explicit photos of herself in exchange for cancelling training, being drunk on duty, and failing to go and lying. Member received a General discharge characterization, resulting in the loss of GI bill benefits.
- A Senior Airman, 54 AMXS, was discharged for Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The member's misconduct included: failure in performance of duties x4, damage to government property, speeding in a school zone, failure to go x2, and failure to obey a direct order.
- An Airman First Class, 54 AMXS, was discharged for Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The member's misconduct included: arrest for failure to comply with probation, failure to go x5, fleeing the scene of an accident, and underage drinking. Member received a General discharge characterization, resulting in the loss of GI bill benefits.
- A Senior Airman, 54 MXS, was discharged for Drug Abuse. The member wrongfully possessed steroids, wrongfully used steroids, and wrongfully possessed marijuana. The member received a General discharge characterization, resulting in the loss of GI bill benefits.

- IAW AFI 51-202, *Nonjudicial Punishment*, Table 3.1, a commander, Lieutenant Colonel or above, imposing Article 15 punishment on a member Senior Airman or below has the authority to impose a reduction in grade all the way to Airman Basic. However, on a Staff Sergeant, Technical Sergeant, or Master Sergeant, the same commander may only impose a one grade reduction.
