## June 2016

Below are the actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of June 2016.

Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum.

### Courts-Martial:

- An Airman First Class, 49 MXS, was court-martialed for unlawfully striking another member's body and head with their hands, and pulling the hair of that member. A panel of officer and enlisted members acquitted the Airman First Class of pulling the hair of the member and found the Airman First Class guilty of unlawfully striking the member. The panel sentenced the Airman First Class to a reduction in grade to E-1, forfeiture of \$500.00 of pay per month for 9 months, restriction to the limits of Holloman Air Force Base for 2 months, and confinement for 5 months.

### Article 15 Actions:

- A Technical Sergeant, 49 SFS, received an Article 15 for making a false official statement. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Staff Sergeant and a suspended forfeiture of \$1,583.00.
- A Senior Airman, 7 ASOS, received an Article 15 for assaulting an NCO. The member received suspended reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, a forfeiture of \$401.00 pay, and a reprimand.
- An Airman First Class, 49 MXS, received an Article 15 for violating a no contact order. The member received a reduction in grade to Airman and 14 days extra duty.
- An Airman First Class, 54 MXS, received an Article 15 for the misuse of a Government Travel Card. The member received 14 days extra duty and a reprimand.

### Administrative Discharges:

- A Staff Sergeant, 49 CES, was taken to a discharge board on the basis of receiving a civilian conviction in Alamogordo, New Mexico. A panel of three members recommended the separation authority retain the member.
