MEMORANDUM FOR HOLLOMAN AFB CHILD & YOUTH PROGRAMS (CYP) PATRONS

SUBJECT: HAFB COVID-19 Directive 2, Change 2 - Holloman AFB Child & Youth Programs Guidance

1. Effective ~~16 March 2020~~ (Change 2 – 20 March 2020), all child and youth participants are restricted from entering any Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB) Child and Youth Program if they have been outside 50 miles from Holloman AFB beginning 16 March 2020, the State of New Mexico, with the exception of El Paso, Texas and Las Cruces, New Mexico. in the last 14 days. Additionally, staff have been directed to monitor participant's temperatures prior to classroom entrance.
2. Patrons, if this impacts your child, please be prepared to undergo a medical screening by the 49th Medical Group (49 MDG) Public Health personnel. Public Health personnel will determine the next steps forward and will make the final determination on when your child is permitted to enter the program.
3. If this directive impacts your ability to perform your duties, please contact your supervisor for further coordination.
4. If either guardian of a child have been placed on Restriction of Movement status, your child is not permitted to enter Child and Youth Programs until you are cleared by 49 MDG Public Health. If you are teleworking we strongly encourage your child does not use the Child and Youth Programs.
5. Truth in reporting regarding you and your child's status is mandatory and part of the service member's duty. Failure to comply could result in administrative or disciplinary action under Article 92, UCMJ.
7. All families who have not utilized child care due to HAFB COVID-19 directives will not be charged for these services, effective as of 16 March 2020. For families who paid in advance, but did not utilize care, you will receive a credit for future services. Children will not lose their child care space if absent from care while HAFB COVID-19 directives are in place.
8. Effective 23 March 2020, only members who have been designated by their unit commander as necessary to mission execution will be allowed to utilize the Child Development Centers or the School Age Program.
