SUBJECT: HAFB COVID-19 Directive 7 – Base Access

1. Installation commanders have the inherent authority to take reasonably necessary actions to protect the health and safety of personnel on the installation and ensure mission accomplishment. This directive is effective 1700L, 20 March 2020 to protect personnel on Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB).
2. Access to HAFB will be limited to the following personnel:
  - a. Active Duty, National Guard, Reserve personnel, and their dependents.
  - b. Contractor and civilian personnel who are executing or supporting their unit mission, as determined by their unit commander.
  - c. Residents of HAFB, including FAM Camp<sup>1</sup>.
  - d. Retired personnel requiring medical care are authorized base access to and from the 49 MDG clinic only. All other base areas are off limits.
  - e. Personnel on an existing visitor pass will be authorized access to HAFB until the expiration of their pass. No new visitor passes will be authorized.
3. Unit commanders have the authority to determine the need for personnel who are executing or supporting the mission IAW para. 2a and 2b, and will send all others home to socially distance (reference HAFB COVID-19 Directive 3 – Social Distancing).
4. Personnel desiring waivers to this directive can work requests through their unit commander up to the 49 WG/CC for decision.
