Holloman Air Force Base is a No Drone Zone

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. —Privately-owned drones and small unmanned aerial vehicles (i.e. quadcopters, radio-controlled airplanes) are prohibited from being operated on Holloman Air Force Base.

This includes the area at the Holloman Wastewater Evaporation Pond that is adjacent to U.S. Highway 70.

Unauthorized drones may be disabled, damaged, destroyed, seized or confiscated. Drone operators may be subject to criminal prosecution, fines, and loss of operator privileges.
