Security Procedures at Holloman AFB 2022 Legacy of Liberty Air Show

HOLLOMAN AIR FORCE BASE, N.M. – The Legacy of Liberty Air Show will occur at Holloman Air Force Base May 7th and 8th, 2022. For the safety and security of all guests, a number of items will not be allowed on base and all spectators will pass through a security checkpoint prior to entering the event. Everyone is subject to search and may be asked to provide proof of identification.

Some of the prohibited items include weapons of any kind, illegal drugs, marijuana in any form (including its derivatives such as THC and Delta-8), ice chests, tents and shade canopies. Pets are not allowed other than certified service animals. There is no parking available for campers, travel trailers or motor homes.

To expedite the security screening process, bags may be no larger than a standard size backpack. Clear or mesh bags are recommended. Diaper bags, small camera bags, and small purses are allowed.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase. If you have special dietary needs, a small amount of food is allowed to be brought in.

Feel free to bring a personal non-glass water bottle, folding chair, stroller or small wagon for your children, a blanket or small personal umbrella to create some shade.
