Below are the administrative actions taken by the 49th Wing during the month of February 2015. Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum. One of the most sacred principles in the justice system is that a defendant is innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

Court-Martial:

- Airman First Class Alexander M. Williams, 16th Training Squadron, was court-martialed and convicted of failure to obey a lawful general order by wrongfully using an intoxicating substance aerosol spray, Dextromethorphan, 25I-NMOMe, Lysergic acid 2, 4-dimethylazetidide, and Diphenhydramine, all in violation of Article 92, UCMJ; wrongful use, manufacture, and distribution of Dimethyltryptamine, all in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ; and wrongful distribution of 25I-NBOMe, and wrongful distribution of Lysergic acid 2, 4-dimethylazetidide, all in violation of Article 134, UCMJ. A military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge, eight months confinement, forfeiture of \$500.00 pay per month for four months, and a reduction to E-1.

Article 15 Action:

- A First Lieutenant, 49th Wing, received nonjudicial punishment for sleeping on duty, and for being drunk while on duty. Punishment consisted of forfeiture of \$1,500.00 pay per month for two months and a reprimand. **In accordance with Article 15, UCMJ, punishment for officers is limited to: 1) restriction for not more than 30 consecutive days; 2) arrest in quarters for not more than 30 consecutive days; 3) forfeiture of not more than one-half of one month's pay per month for two months; and 4) restriction for not more than 60 consecutive days*

Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman Basic, 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, was discharged for Drug Abuse: member wrongfully used oxycodone. Member received a General Discharge, resulting in loss of GI bill benefits.
- An Airman, 49th Logistic Readiness Squadron, was discharged for failing to maintain Fitness Standards. Member received an Honorable Discharge.
