## January 2015

Below are the administrative actions taken by the 49th Wing during the month of January 2015. Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum. One of the most sacred principles in the justice system is that a defendant is innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

### Court-Martial:

- Airman James W. Oliver III, 49th Security Forces Squadron, was court-martialed and convicted of wrongful use of marijuana on divers occasions, wrongful use of Methylenedioxyamphetamine, and wrongful use of cocaine, all in violation of Article 112a, UCMJ. A military judge sentenced him to five months confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000.00 pay per month for five months, and a reduction to E-1.

### Article 15 Actions:

- A Senior Airman, 9th Attack Squadron, received nonjudicial punishment for wrongfully utilizing his Government Travel card account. Punishment consisted of suspended reduction to the grade of Airman First Class and a reprimand.
- A Staff Sergeant, 54th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, received nonjudicial punishment for driving while under the influence of alcohol. Punishment consisted of reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, suspended forfeiture of \$250.00 pay per month for two months, 30 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

### Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman, 49th Medical Support Squadron, was discharged for Minor Disciplinary Infractions: numerous instances of failure to obey a lawful order, failure to go, and dereliction in the performance of duties. Member received a General Discharge, resulting in the loss of all GI bill benefits.
- A Senior Airman, 49th Materiel Maintenance Support Squadron, was discharged for Drug Abuse: member transported drugs with the intent to sell and is being prosecuted by the civilian authorities. Member received a General Discharge, resulting in the loss of GI bill benefits.
- An Airman Basic, 49th Security Forces Squadron, was discharged for Conduct Prejudicial to Good Order and Discipline: disorderly in the dorms, leaving the scene of an accident. Member received a General Discharge, resulting in loss of GI bill benefits.
- An Airman First Class, 49th Operations Support Squadron, was discharged for Drug Abuse: member wrongfully used an amphetamine. Member received a General Discharge, resulting in loss of GI bill benefits.
