Below are actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of December 2017.

Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum.

Courts-Martial:

- A Senior Airman, 49th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, was court-martialed for wrongful use of marijuana and
 wrongfully introducing marijuana onto a military installation. The member pled guilty to the charges and its specifications. A Summary Court-Martial Official sentenced the member to be reprimanded, to forfeit \$1,020.00 pay, and to
 perform hard labor for 30 days.
- An Airman First Class, 49th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, was court-martialed for wrongful use of marijuana and
 the wrongful use of 3,4-Methylenedioxyamphetamine (MDA), a Schedule I controlled substance. The member pled
 guilty to the charges and its specifications. A panel of members sentenced the member to be reduced to the grade of
 Airman Basic, to forfeit \$1,066.00 pay per month for six months, and to be confined for two months
- An Airman, 49th Logistics Readiness Squadron, was court-martialed for wrongful use of marijuana and the wrongful
 use of Methylenedioxy-Amphetamine (MDA), a Schedule I controlled substance. The member pled guilty to the
 charges and its specifications. A panel of members sentenced the member to be reduced to the grade of Airman
 Basic, and to be discharged from the service with a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Article 15 Actions:

None.

Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman First Class, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for failure to progress in military training required to be qualified for service with the Air Force. The member received an Honorable discharge characterization.
- An Airman Basic, 49th Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for action tantamount to a finding of guilty in a civilian court proceeding. The member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge characterization.
- A Senior Airman, 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, was discharged for fraudulent enlistment. The member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge characterization.

Tip of the Month:

• Per "Unaccompanied Housing Personnel Resident Guide", 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, Holloman AFB, NM, para. 3.1, all guests must be 18 years of age or older, be escorted at all times, and are prohibited between the hours of 0000-0600. Cohabitation or the appearance of cohabitation is prohibited. Failure to follow these rules may result in being in violation of Article 92, failure to obey a lawful order and Article 134, wrongful cohabitation.
