Below are actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of November 2017.

Courts-Martial:

- None.

Article 15 Actions:

- A Senior Airman, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, received an Article 15 for wrongful use of Oxymorphone, a Schedule II controlled substance. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman and a reprimand.
- A Senior Airman, 54th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, received an Article 15 for an assault consummated by battery. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, suspended forfeitures of \$1,002.00 pay per month for two months, suspended extra duties for 30 days, and a reprimand.
- An Airman First Class, 635th Materiel Maintenance Squadron, received an Article 15 for failure to go, AWOL, and wrongfully having his girlfriend spend the night and stay unattended in his dorm room. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic, restriction to Holloman AFB for 15 days, and a reprimand.
- An Airman First Class, 49th Force Support Squadron, received an Article 15 for GTC misuse. The member received a suspended reduction to Airman and a reprimand. The suspension was later vacated and the member reduced in full.
- An Airman, 16th Training Squadron, received an Article 15 for failure to adhere to the Initial Transition Phase policy by not wearing appropriate military attire when outside of his dorm room. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman, forfeiture of \$100.00 pay per month for two months, and a reprimand.
- An Airman, 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, received an Article 15 for wrongfully driving his vehicle on base while his driving privileges were revoked. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman Basic, forfeitures of \$200.00 pay per month for two months, and a reprimand.
- An Airman, 49th Logistics Readiness Squadron, received an Article 15 for violating a no-contact order. The member received forfeitures of \$200.00 pay per month for two months and a reprimand.

Administrative Discharges:

- An Airman First Class, 54th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for conditions that interfere with military service and minor disciplinary infractions. The member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge characterization.
- An Airman First Class, 49th Communications Squadron, was discharged for conditions that interfere with military service. The member received a Honorable discharge characterization.
- An Airman, 49th Operations Support Squadron, was discharged for drug abuse. The member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge characterization.

- Per "Unaccompanied Housing Personnel Resident Guide", 49th Civil Engineer Squadron, Holloman AFB, NM, para. 3.1, all guests must be 18 years of age or older, be escorted at all times, and are prohibited between the hours of 0000-0600. Cohabitation or the appearance of cohabitation is prohibited. Failure to follow these rules may result in being in violation of Article 92, failure to obey a lawful order and Article 134, wrongful cohabitation.
