Below are the actions taken at Holloman AFB during the month of September 2016.

Names are withheld when appropriate to the forum.

Courts-Martial:

- Senior Airman Tyrus J. Wilcox, 49th Security Forces Squadron, was court-martialed for Driving While Intoxicated and assaulting an Airman by pointing a loaded firearm at him. The member plead guilty to Driving While Intoxicated. A panel of officer members found the member guilty of pointing the loaded firearm at the Airman. The panel sentenced the member to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to be confined for 100 days, and to be discharged from the service with a Bad-Conduct Discharge.

Article 15 Actions:

- An Airman First Class, 49th Civil Engineering Squadron received an Article 15 for wrongfully using marijuana. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman Basic and a reprimand.
- A Senior Airman, 49th Medical Support Squadron, received an Article 15 for wrongful use of marijuana. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, 14 days extra duty, and a reprimand
- A Captain, 16th Training Squadron, received an Article 15 for driving in a reckless manner, by texting and driving at a speed in excess of 100 miles per hour. The member received a forfeiture of \$2,643.00 per month for two months and a reprimand.
- An Airman First Class, 54th Operations Support Squadron, received an Article 15 for committing two counts of abusive sexual contact. The member received a reduction to the grade of Airman, a suspended forfeiture of \$878.00 per month for two months, and a reprimand.
- A Senior Airman, 49th Logistic Readiness Squadron, received an Article 15 for communicating a threat. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman First Class, forfeiture of \$250.00 pay per month for two months, and a reprimand.
- A Staff Sergeant, 7th Air Support Operations Squadron, received an Article 15 for using their Government Travel Card to pay for unauthorized expenses. The member received a suspended reduction to the grade of Senior Airman, 30 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

Administrative Discharges:

- A Senior Airman, 49th Security Forces Squadron, was discharged for a pattern of misconduct. Member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge.
- An Airman Basic, 49th Civil Engineering Squadron, was discharged for drug abuse and a pattern of misconduct. Member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge.
- An Airman First Class, 54th Maintenance Squadron, was discharged for minor disciplinary infractions. Member received an Under Honorable Conditions (General) discharge.
